

OPENING THE VOTING MACHINE



After the Voting Machine is set up, you must open the machine and run the zero proof report. This should be done before 6 a.m. Voters are permitted to vote starting at 6 a.m.




REMINDER: WHEN TO USE THE AFFIRMATION OF RESIDENCY FORM

- When "VERIFY ADDRESS" is displayed in voter signature box have the voter fill out the Affirmation of Residency form (yellow single sheet) provided by the Superintendent of Elections. This is found in your supplies. Be sure the form is completely filled out. Compare information on form with that printed above the voter's signature box. **No other proof of residency is required. Do not ask for ID.**

MUST first complete the yellow "Affirmation of Residency" Form. Verify if the address provided on the form matches the information in the Poll Book. If yes, allow the Voter to vote on the machine, If not, offer the voter a PROVISIONAL BALLOT

- Deceased Voter:** If a family member informs you that a voter is deceased, have the family member use the space provided on the "Affirmation of Residency" form to notify the Superintendent of Elections. Return completed "Affirmation of Residency" Forms with your supplies.

ADA Compliance Corner

It is important to note that any voter may request assistance with voting from anyone other than a candidate on the ballot, their employer or a union official. For each voter that requires assistance, the **Disability Certificate for Assistance Form** must be completed. This form is located at the front of the poll book.

Audio Kit for Voters

One voting machine at your district will be equipped with an Audio Device for use by visually impaired voters.

Wheelchair Accessibility

For a voter in a wheelchair, the height of the machine may be adjusted by simply using the latch to accommodate voters.

*Please contact the Board of Elections immediately, if there any concerns about addressing a voter's needs.

Polling Place Etiquette

- ◆ Poll Workers must arrive at 5:15 a.m. and stay at the polling place until the close of polls. If there is an issue, you must notify the Board of Elections immediately.
- ◆ Poll Workers should refrain from bringing their children to the polls.
- ◆ Please put all electronic devices away when voters are present.
- ◆ Poll Workers should not accept food from candidates or campaign workers. This is considered **electioneering** and is not permitted.
- ◆ List **ALL** issues encountered on Election Day on the Incident Report.

*Please take the time to review our recently revised **Instruction Book, Step-by-Step Instructions for Operating the Voting Machine and Check Sheet.** These guides address most questions that may occur on Election Day.*

Voter's Name Has Changed

Registered voters who have changed their name due to marriage, divorce or court decree, may be permitted to vote under the original registration after signing the "Signature Box" - *as shown below* - with the original name AND then the new name. This is permitted if their mailing address **has not** changed.
