Effective April 2010, contractors property owners and maintenance staff performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities, and schools built before 1978 must be certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination.

To become a Certified Renovator you must successfully complete an EPA-accredited renovator course.

Day 1: 8:00 am—5:00 pm **(Initial)**

Day 2: 8:00 am—5:00 pm **(Dust Wipe)**

INITIAL: This 1-day (8-hr) class explains how to comply with EPA's Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Rule. Subjects covered include: health effects, regulations, lead safe work practices, containment, cleaning, training non-certified renovation workers & record keeping. After achieving a proficient rating for hands-on activities and passing an end-of-class exam, students receive RRP Certificates.

DUST WIPE: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) and Office of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) have produced this course to teach individuals how to conduct non-abatement lead dust clearance testing. This course is designed to be taught over an 8-hour time period with 2 hours devoted to hands-on training.

Includes continental breakfast and lunch for both days, course materials and EPA certificate of completion.
