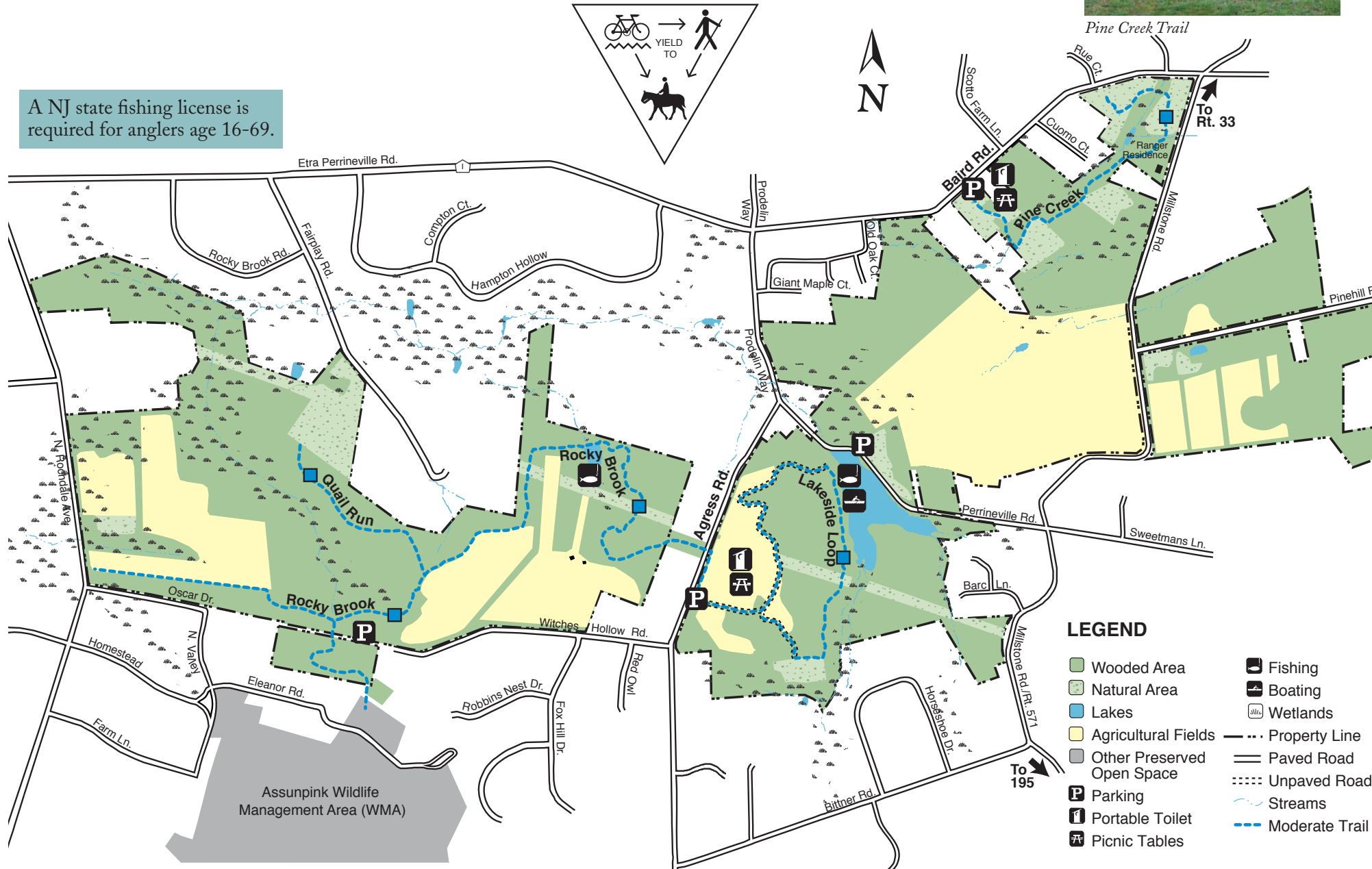
P Baird Road
 (GPS: Use 143 Baird Rd.)
 Grasslands and forest combine at this site for a pleasant walk.



P Agress Road
 (GPS: Use 23 Agress Rd.)
 There are two trails accessible from this lot, on either side of Agress Road.



A NJ state fishing license is required for anglers age 16-69.



Trail Key

Multi-use: open to hikers/bicyclists & equestrians

- Rocky Brook:** This moderate 2.4 mile trail meanders past a fishing pond, through forest and agricultural fields on its way out to North Rochdale Ave. A 0.4 mile spur connects the trail to Assunpink WMA.
- Lakeside Loop:** Follow an old farm road with views of Perrineville Lake on this moderate 1.5 mile loop.
- Pine Creek Trail:** Walk this moderate 1 mile trail through fields and tall pines.

Pedestrian only:

- Quail Run:** Follow this 0.5 mile path to extend your forested walk along Rocky Brook.

Trail Standards

- Easy:** short, well-maintained or paved trails intended for casual walking (none at this site)
- Moderate:** longer trails with some grades/obstructions; intended for hiking (may be suitable for some walkers and runners)
- Challenging:** long, more primitive trails with steep grades, obstructions; intended for hardy, experienced hikers (none at this site)
