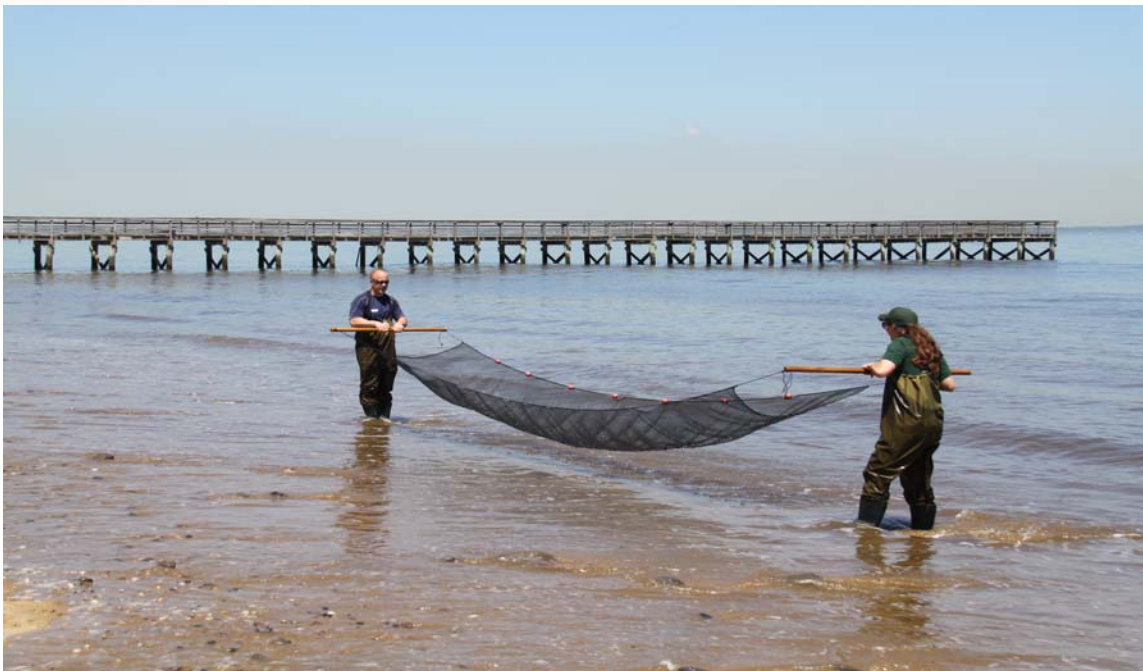




Free seining at Bayshore Waterfront Park this summer!
