



HISTORIC LONGSTREET FARM SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

Drop Off & Pick Up

The day begins and ends at the Longstreet Farm Visitor Center located adjacent to the main parking lot at Holmdel Park. Parents/Guardians must sign their child in and out each day. Be sure to list all authorized parents/guardians/caregivers on the Participant Information Sheet in the camp forms packet (available at www.monmouthcountyparks.com).

Please be prompt for drop off and pick up. Drop off is not permitted more than 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the camp.

Release Form and Medical Information Sheet

The camp form packet with all four forms and special accommodation forms, if needed, must be completed and returned prior to attending camp. Forms can be found at www.monmouthcountyparks.com or call 732 842-4000, ext. 4312, to have them mailed to you.

Lunch/Snacks

For half-day camps, each camper should bring a snack and drink each day. For full-day camps, each camper should bring a lunch, snacks and drinks. There is no food concession in the park.

Out of consideration of others with allergies, we ask that you not send snacks with nuts or nut byproducts.

Attire

Campers should wear comfortable clothing, sturdy closed-toe shoes (no flip-flops or sandals), socks, and a hat. Sunscreen is also recommended.

Overnight

For the “Life on the Farm” camp there will be an overnight in the Longstreet Farm Visitor Center on Thursday. The recommended overnight attire is sweat suits.
