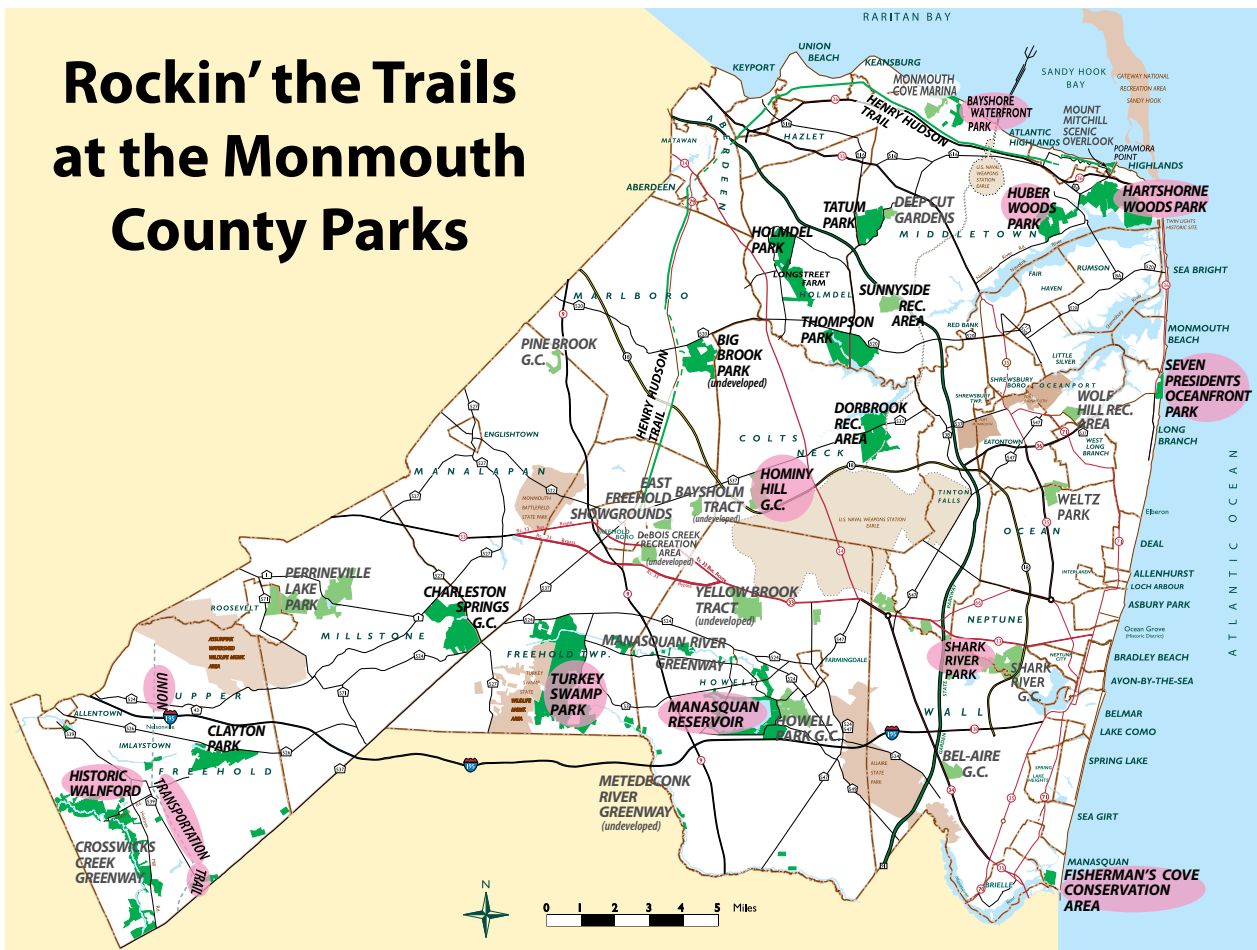


Rockin' the Trails at the Monmouth County Parks

Here's how it works:

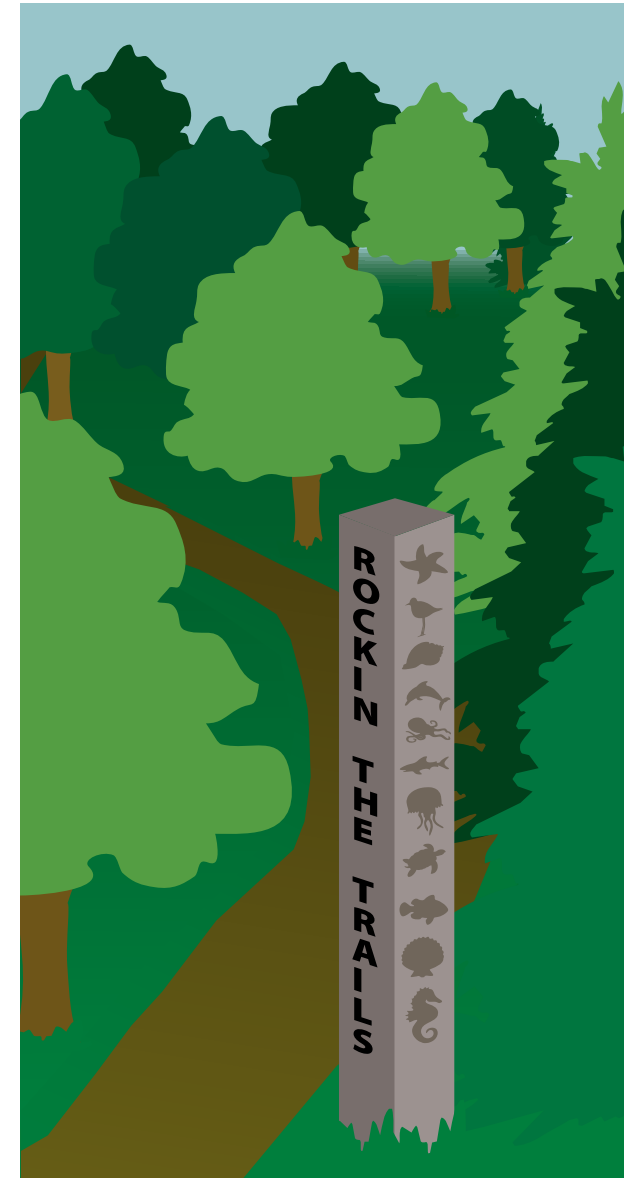
- Visit the 8 parks listed in this brochure. Take the trail indicated to locate the Rockin' the Trails post.
- Follow the directions for each park that will tell you which sea critters to count.
- Write the number in the box next to the park description.
- The numbers you collect make up the combination for a locked treasure box. Each column is a treasure box group. Once you complete a combination, visit the designated park to open the treasure box.
- Follow the directions inside the treasure box to complete the Mystery Phrase.
- Bring your completed brochure to the Huber Woods Environmental Center or the Manasquan Reservoir Environmental Center to receive your prize and enter to win the Grand Prize Drawing.
- There is no cost for participating and you may complete the hunt at your own pace.

Stroll along the boardwalk through the dunes between the Pavilion and Tony's Place playground area. Count the number of red fish and record the number in the brochure.

From the parking area, walk south towards the creek and look for the post near the white Carriage House. Count the number of blue jellyfish and record the number in the brochure.

Park at the Main Street Parking Lot. Follow the trail west towards the Activity Center. Count the number of yellow sea stars and purple sea turtles; record the combined total in the brochure.

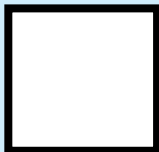
