MONMOUTH COUNTY PARK SYSTEM TO HOLD FRESHWATER FISHING DERBY



HOWELL & FREEHOLD - There's nothing quite like the thrill of feeling a tug at the end of your fishing pole. Discover for yourself when the Monmouth County Park System celebrates the state's no-license-required-fishing weekend, June 20 & 21, with pole rentals, fishing clinics and its *Freshwater Fishing Derby*. The fun starts on Saturday, June 20 at the Manasquan Reservoir in Howell. The Park System will hold a free hands-on fishing clinic from 12:30-1:30 p.m. which will cover how to cast and rig. Staff will be on hand to answer any questions. Then the fishing derby will be held from 2-5 p.m. On Sunday, June 21, the action moves to Turkey Swamp Park, Freehold. Once again a free hands-on fishing clinic will be held from 12:30-1:30 p.m., followed by the fishing derby from 2-5 p.m.

Prizes will be awarded for the longest fish in three different categories. Derby rules provided upon registration. Anglers can bring their own fishing pole or rent one for \$5. The cost of each day of the fishing derby is \$25 per family of 4 or \$8 per person. A container of worms is included with each registration.

Pre-registration is suggested; walk-ins are welcome (cash or check only on site).
