RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 09-438 APPOINTING ENVIRONMENTAL CONNECTION, INC. TO PROVIDE ON-CALL PROFESSIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO ASBESTOS AND LEAD BASED PAINT AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS (\$9,300)

WHEREAS, by Resolution 09-438 the Board of Chosen Freeholders appointed Environmental Connection, Inc. of Trenton, New Jersey, to provide on-call professional environmental engineering services related to asbestos and lead based paint for the period beginning on May 1, 2009 and ending on April 30, 2010 for a maximum fee of \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, more professional environmental engineering services have been required than had been anticipated; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated March 3, 2010, Environmental Connection, Inc. has offered to provide additional as needed on-call professional environmental engineering services related to asbestos and lead based paint for an additional fee of \$9,300; and

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, having carefully considered the matter, and relying substantially on the recommendations of Robert W. Lahey, Superintendent of Buildings & Grounds and William Wood, Director of Administrative Services, finds that Environmental Connection, Inc.'s maximum additional fee of \$9,300 fairly and reasonably reflects the anticipated scope of the additional professional environmental engineering services that are to be provided; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds to pay Environmental Connection, Inc.'s additional maximum fee of \$9,300 are available in account 9-01-26-310-170-338.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth that Resolution 09-438 be and is hereby amended to increase the maximum authorized fee by \$9,300 for a revised maximum fee of \$59,300.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any fees for additional work over the \$59,300 provided for in this resolution will be authorized only upon the approval of the Board prior to the additional services being performed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in all other respects Resolution 09-438 remains in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional service in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk cause notice of this action to be printed in an official newspaper of the County of Monmouth.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk forward certified true copies of this resolution to Environmental Connection, Inc., the Division of Purchasing, Mr. Wood and Mr. Lahey.

Dear Mr. Aravich:

As requested, Environmental Connection, Inc., (EC) is providing a proposal for additional contract funding as the existing allowance of \$50,000 for the one (1) year term May 1, 2009 - April 30, 2010 is almost exhausted, due to the large volume of work requested and performed to date. This includes the initial inspection of the Court house project and the design of Plans and Specifications for the same, the re-inspection of four (4) county buildings the collection of bulk samples for an issue at the Juvenile Detention Center and the protracted project monitoring of the work performed by the successful contractor awarded the work Firing Range Lead clean-up project.

Completion of all projects currently in progress will require that an estimated \$9,300.00 be added to the existing contract fund for the completion of existing open projects that includes the final reporting and the associated project close-out documentation of the Police Academy Firing Range lead cleanup in the amount of \$4,700, the emergency response asbestos clean-up of the Court House West Wing room #1 for \$2,600.00 and the monitoring of the Court House asbestos removal for \$2,000.00.
