

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
ON THE MONMOUTH COUNTY
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE FY2013, FY2014, AND FY2015 ANNUAL ACTION PLANS

The Monmouth County Office of Community Development is proposing to amend its FY2013 and FY2014 One Year Action Plan components of the 2010-2014 Consolidated Plan and its FY2015 One Year Action Plan component of the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan. Monmouth County expects to submit the Substantial Amendments to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before December 31, 2016.

The County's Annual Action Plans identify the needs of homeless, low-income and special needs populations and describe activities the consortium intends to undertake to address the priorities and specific objectives for housing and community development. In addition, the Plans identify the public and private funding sources that will be used to carry out the needs and objectives outlined in the Plans.

The Monmouth County Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) requires a 30 day public comment period which will start at midnight February 22, 2016 and end at midnight March 23, 2016.

The FY2013 & FY2014 Substantial Amendments transfer available CDBG project balances to fund six new CDBG projects. The FY2015 Substantial Amendments transfer previously unallocated HOME funds to three new HOME projects, and also transfer available CDBG project balances to fund five new CDBG projects. Details of the new projects and funding amounts are provided in the amendments.
