

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
On the
FY 2016 Annual Action Plan
For HUD Programs Administered by the Monmouth County Office of Community Development

The Monmouth County Office of Community Development has prepared the FY2016 Annual Action Plan for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on or before November 13, 2015.

The FY2016 Annual Action Plan identifies the needs of the homeless, low-income, and special needs populations, and describes activities the consortium intends to undertake towards addressing the priorities and specific objectives for housing and community development. Additionally, the Plan identifies the public and private funding sources that will be used to carry out the needs and objectives outlined within the Plan.

The thirty-day public comment period will start on Monday, September 21, 2015 and continue through and include Tuesday, October 20, 2015.
