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GENERAL INFORMATION AND IN-SERVICE RULES

Course Information

All in-service training courses held during the daytime will begin at 9:00 a.m. and conclude at 5:00 p.m. unless otherwise specified by the instructor. Hours for the Basic Course for Police Officers will accompany the application when issued.

Registration

Registration forms are accepted on a **first come, first served basis**, so it is advantageous to register for a course at your earliest convenience. Shortly after a registration form is received by the academy, it will be faxed back to the sender advising of one of the following; confirming admittance, denying admittance, or placing the requesting personnel on a waiting list. In the event that additional openings occur, these positions will be filled from the waiting list and the participant will be notified to attend. Registration forms may be faxed to 732-577-8722 or mailed to the academy. **SEATS FOR COURSES WILL NO LONGER BE RESERVED WITHOUT THE NAME OF THE PARTICIPANT.**

Registration Fee

Registration fees for all in-service training courses are listed on the application.

Registration Forms

Registration forms are included in this catalog or may be downloaded at www.monmouthcountypoliceacademy.com. All forms **must** be signed by your department head or a designee. A blank registration form is provided for courses that are added after this catalog goes to print.

Medical Clearance

The academy will no longer require that participants receive medical clearance prior to attending certain physically demanding in-service courses. It is strongly suggested that prior to attending any course that requires physical excursion that the attendee consult his or her physician to assure that they are healthy enough to participate in such activities. A waiver form will be required in order to participate in these courses.

Certificates

Certificates of completion will be awarded the last day of instruction to individual officers successfully completing the course.

Accidents

In any incident where a person is injured or may have been injured, a Monmouth County Incident Report should be completed with all necessary information. A copy should be placed in the Academy's Incident File and the original should be sent to Ms. Clair Joyce, Insurance Department, Hall of Records.

Telephone Messages

Messages will be posted on the classroom door, to be picked up during breaks. Pagers and cell phones should be set to the silent mode.

Smoking

Smoking is *not* permitted in the building. Smoking is permitted outside the building in the rear. Cigarette butts should be disposed of in the receptacles provided 25' from the building.

Breaks

Breaks are given about every hour according to the instructor. Lunch breaks are at the discretion of the instructor.

Eating/Drinking/Newspapers

Eating and drinking are permitted only in the lounge area. Students are required to clean up after themselves. All garbage should be disposed of in the receptacles provided. Newspapers and periodicals not related to the training program are not to be read during class.

Class Attendance

Class attendance is required. Any absences will be reported to your department. If your absence is due to court, illness, etc, the academy shall be notified. No certificate will be issued if more than 10% of a class has been missed.

Miscellaneous/Order

In-service attendees are prohibited from talking to any Basic Training trainees; Regular, Corrections Officer, SLEO II or SLEO I. In-service students are expected to set an example for basic trainees, by refraining from using profane, loud, or offensive language while at the academy. Officers are not to interfere with, or bother any trainee. All students are expected to treat instructors with courtesy and respect.

Dress Code

Males

- Conservative casual business attire
- Or regular department uniform
- Or sport jacket, trousers
- All shirts must have collars
- Civilian ties and/or suits are optional

Females

- Conservative casual business attire
- Casual suit
- Or skirt, blouse and/or sweater
- Or pants, slacks, blouse and/or sweater
- Suits and skirt lengths must be “business length

Exceptions and adjustments to the standard dress code

- Dress may be modified at the request of the instructors
- Trainees in the Basic Course training
- Persons attending physical courses such as firearms, side-handle baton, defensive tactics, etc.
- MCSO – Citizen’s Police Academy
- Sheriff’s Youth Week
- Other classes/courses as determined by the Director of the Police Academy.

Prohibited full-time attire

- Jeans
- Shorts
- Sweat/workout clothing
- Sneakers, sandals, moccasins, flipflops
- Shirts without collars
- Any clothing displaying advertising, cartoons, slogans or humor
- Any sexually provocative or otherwise inappropriate attire.

Any person(s) not complying with the dress code(s) will be refused admittance to a class/course.

DIRECTIONS TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY POLICE ACADEMY

NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE (FROM SOUTH JERSEY)

NJ Turnpike North to exit 7A (I-195 "Shorepoints"). Take Route I-195 East to exit #16. Take Route 537 East to Freehold. Travel through and out of the Freehold business district to traffic light – KOZLOSKI ROAD. Turn right onto KOZLOSKI ROAD, go ¼ mile to light and Academy is on the right.

NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE (FROM NORTH JERSEY)

NJ Turnpike South to exit #11. As you leave the tollgates stay to the left and get on the Garden State Pkwy South to exit 123. Take Route 9 South for 7.3 miles; stay left to Route 18. Take Route 18 South to Exit 22B. Take Route 537 West just before the second traffic light – KOZLOSKI ROAD SOUTH.

GARDEN STATE PARKWAY (FROM SOUTH JERSEY)

GSP North to exit 100B to Route 33 west. Go west on Route 33 to Collingwood Circle. Take Route 34 North for 1 mile (stay left) to Route 33 West. Follow Route 33 West past Monmouth County Fire Academy and stay to the right (Business District). Continue on Route 33 (business) west. Continue past WaWa convenience store. Approaching next traffic light at an overpass (gasoline station on right) stay in left lane and watch for sign for Kozloski Road north. At the traffic light next to gasoline station turn left and follow sign to Kozloski Road north. Travel ¾ mile on Kozloski Road to 2nd light (intersection with Burlington Road) and the Academy will be on the left.

GARDEN STATE PARKWAY (FROM NORTH JERSEY)

GSP South to exit 123. Take Route 9 South for 7.3 miles; stay left to Route 18. Take Route 18 South to Exit 22B. Take Route 537 West just before the second traffic light – follow the sign for KOZLOSKI ROAD SOUTH. Continue south on Kozloski Road. At second light the Academy is on the right.
