BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE #15-05 TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION TO PROVIDE FOR BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS FOR AND BY THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bond Ordinance #15-05 of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Board") entitled "Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$46,420,000 For Various Improvements And Purposes For And By The County Of Monmouth, New Jersey, And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$44,195,000 Bonds Or Notes Of The County For Financing Part Of The Cost Thereof", finally adopted on May 28, 2015 (the "Ordinance") is hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety.

Section 2: Exhibit I (1) of the Ordinance is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the additional project "Bridge Improvements, including but not limited to improvements in connection with County Bridges: S-14 (Middletown/Colts Neck/Tinton Falls), HL-06 (Howell), A-4 (Colts Neck), HL-18 (Howell), MA-11 (Matawan), U-15 (Upper Freehold), MT-20 (Middletown), S-26 (Little Silver), HL-67 (Howell), HL-64 (Howell), R-27 (Keansburg), W-36 (Wall), O-7 (Ocean), MT-32 (Middletown), R-12 (Keansburg), HL-20 (Howell), S-32 (Rumson/Sea Bright), MT-17b, (Highlands), MT-61 (Middletown), R-30 (Keansburg) and S-24 (Little Silver), including engineering and design and inspection and general renovations. Roadway resurfacing at various locations in the County, including Ocean Avenue in Bradley Beach, Avon By-the-Sea, Belmar and Spring Lake, and First Avenue/The Crescent in Sea Girt", and by deleting the reference of 21.08 years in said section for the useful life and substituting in lieu therefor 19.53 years, and by deleting the reference of 15.83 years for the useful life in Section 6(b) of the Ordinance and substituting in lieu therefor 15.135 years.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Board is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolutions in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. All other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain unchanged.

Section 5. This bond ordinance having been introduced at the meeting of October 8, 2015, read and passed upon first reading, be considered for second reading and final passage at
