

**BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE  
#2017-0544 TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION OF CERTAIN  
IMPROVEMENTS TO PROVIDE FOR FALLEN LAW  
ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL AT PROSECUTOR'S  
OFFICE COMPLEX FOR AND BY THE COUNTY OF  
MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bond Ordinance #2017-0544 of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Board") entitled "Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$46,038,000 For Various Improvements And Purposes For And By The County Of Monmouth, New Jersey, And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$43,835,000 Bonds Or Notes Of The County For Financing Part Of The Cost Thereof", finally adopted on July 13, 2017 (the "Ordinance") is hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety.

Section 2: (a) Exhibit I (1) of the Ordinance is hereby amended by (i) adding at the end thereof the additional project "Fallen Law Enforcement Memorial at the Prosecutor's Office Complex" and (ii) deleting the reference of 5 years in said section for the useful life and substituting in lieu therefor 5.11 years.

(b) Exhibit I (3) of the Ordinance is hereby amended by (i) adding at the end thereof the additional project "Fallen Law Enforcement Memorial at the Prosecutor's Office Complex" and (ii) deleting the reference of 11.23 years in said section for the useful life and substituting in lieu therefor 11.35 years.

(c) Section 6(b) of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the reference of 14.96 years for the useful life and substituting in lieu therefor 14.98 years.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Board is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolutions in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. All other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain unchanged.

Section 5. This amendatory bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
