NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Chosen Freeholders proclaim the month of July 2011 as:



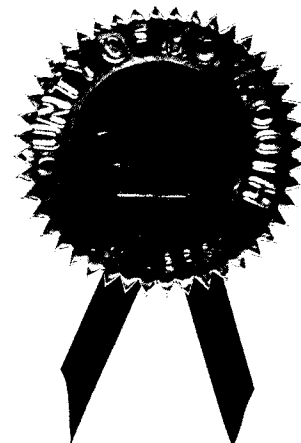

Honoring Kelly Breen

WHEREAS, Kelly Breen, whose affection for horse racing began at age 13, became an assistant trainer at age 18, working with Walter Reese; and

WHEREAS, Kelly saddled his first winner in 1992, and while working as an assistant to Ben Perkins, Sr., saddled some notable sprinters-all-stakes winners who ran their way to Breeders Cup appearances; and

WHEREAS, in 2000, Kelly Breen began training on his own, and since that time has been almost a fixture in the winner's circle at Monmouth Park, where he was the leading trainer in 2005 and 2006 and, in August 2007, Kelly Breen accomplished a rare feat when he saddled an entry of Presidential Thoroughbreds, "Second Collection" and "Findee's Keepee's" and the two horses finished in a dead heat for first at Monmouth Park; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 he became the trainer for Lori and George Hall of Rumson, and together, this trainer/owner team had entries in its first Kentucky Derby in 2009, and has trained horses for the three Triple Crown races, Kentucky Derby, Preakness and The Belmont Stakes; is hoping to make back-to-back appearances in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, June 4th, 2011, "Ruler on Ice" owned by George and Lori Hall of Monmouth County and trained by Kelly Breen won the third race of the Triple Crown, the much coveted Belmont Stakes.

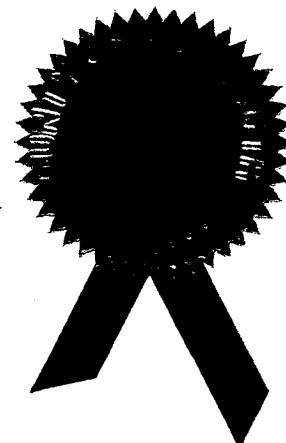

Honoring the Retirement of Rabbi Kenneth Greene

WHEREAS, earning his rabbinical degree in 1973 from the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, Rabbi Kenneth Green began his career in Windsor, Connecticut in the pulpit rabbinate; and

WHEREAS, throughout the years, Rabbi Greene received a Master's Degree in Education, a certificate in Marriage and Family and a Master's Degree in Counseling and a Doctorate from Spertus Institute of Jewish Studies; and

WHEREAS, in August of 1997 Rabbi Kenneth Greene began his service as spiritual leader of Freehold Jewish Center, where during his 15 years of service and inspiration to the community, Rabbi Green was instrumental in introducing educational programs for congregants of all ages, and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2011 Rabbi Kenneth Greene will conduct his last service at the John L. Montgomery Care Center where he has served as chaplain for fourteen years, serving the community as a source of solace, inspiration and spiritual guidance.

"Rabbi Kenneth Greene Day"

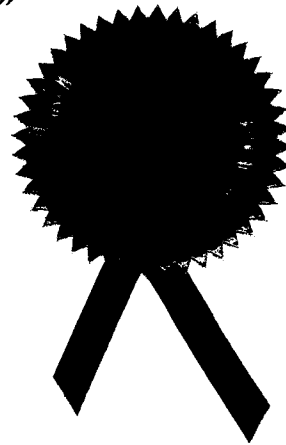
