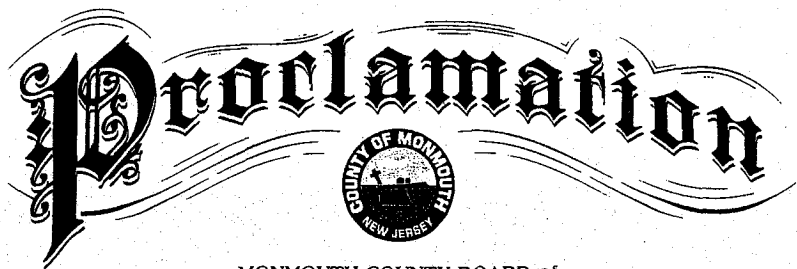


WORK SESSION AGENDA ITEM #1 – PROCLAMATIONS

WHEREAS, Lionism began in the United States in 1917, when a group of independent clubs responded to the ideal of "service to their fellow man" without regard to politics, religion, race or the personal interests of the members; and

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2008, the Lions Club of Glendola, founded by Melvin Jones and the families and friends who have dedicated themselves to helping their community will officially join the 1.3 million members of Lions International World Wide; and

WHEREAS, members of the Glendola Lions Club, with the motto "We Serve" as a guide are proud to join forces in aiding the Monmouth County Association for the Blind, families devastated by disasters as well as helping to address many needs that are currently unmet by other community projects; and
