

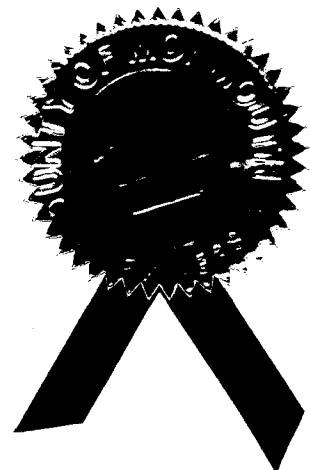

Kimisis for Autism

WHEREAS, *Kimisis for Autism* is an organization formed under the advisement of the *Kimisis Tis Theotokou Greek Orthodox Church* in Holmdel, with the mission of raising awareness about autism and funding for *Autism Speaks*; and

WHEREAS, since 2005, *Autism Speaks* has been recognized for spearheading awareness to educate parents, professionals and the general public about autism and its effects, while providing research dollars for autism spectrum disorder (ASD); and

WHEREAS, autism is a pervasive developmental disorder affecting the social, learning and behavioral skills of those affected by it and although once thought to be a relatively rare disorder, it is estimated that ASD effects one in every 110 children, and one in 70 boys; and

WHEREAS, ASD which includes High Functioning Autism, Autism, Asperger's Syndrome and Pervasive Developmental Disorder manifests itself in the first three years of life and knows no racial, ethnic or social boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the fact that currently there is no medical detection or cure for autism, it is essential that when ASD is suspected an acute, early diagnosis accompanied by appropriate education is vital to the growth and development of the affected individual; and

WHEREAS, with help from *Kimisis for Autism*, advocacy organizations like *Autism Speaks* can continue to help fund research into the causes, prevention, treatments and a cure for autism, increase awareness of autism, and advocate for the needs of individuals with autism and their families.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Chosen Freeholders, commends *Kimisis for Autism* for their outstanding community service and hereby proclaims October 16, 2010 as

"Kimisis for Autism Day"

in the entire County of Monmouth.

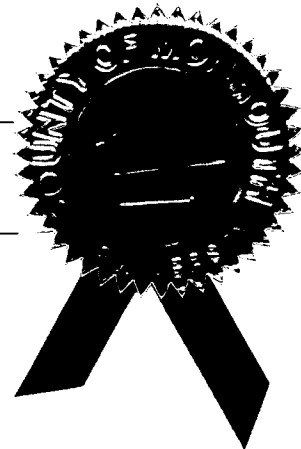

WHEREAS, in addition to his considerable talent as a chef, for 35 years Dennis Foy has pursued a painting career, and has had his work featured in Canvassing the Coast: Contemporary Paintings Inspired by the New Jersey Shore, a gallery exhibition and in the book "To the Shore Once More" a collection of regional coastal painters.
