



ASSUMPTIONS

Please see the following pages for our sample fee structure for Monmouth County. Included in our sample fee structure are the following assumptions:

- ▲ Consulting contract begins in January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2024 with three (3) one -year renewal options
- ▲ Administering and managing current natural gas and electricity contracts
- ▲ Natural gas supply contracts starting November 2023 (October meter read) for approximately 110,146 DTH (estimated)
- ▲ Electricity supply contracts starting August 2023 for approximately 34 million kWh (estimated)
- ▲ Peak Demand email alerts sent to contact the team to provide notice of market conditions.
- ▲ Potential enrollment of all accounts into Titan Energy Intelligence, web-based utility data reporting program to help with reporting market intelligence and performance tracking/benchmarking will be negotiated per contract.
- ▲ For any standalone energy efficiency or generation projects administered by the consultant, the consultant may be compensated at an agreed-upon fee in addition to the fee described below.
