This notice is published pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:12-7. A General Election will be held Tuesday, November 3, 2026, between the hours of 6:00 AM and 8:00 PM to elect candidates to public office and to vote on public questions.

VOTING REQUIREMENTS

To vote in Monmouth County, you must be a United States citizen, you will be 18 years of age by the next election, you will be a resident of the State and County 30 days before the election, and you are NOT currently serving a sentence of incarceration due to a conviction for an indictable offense under any federal or State laws. Registration deadline is 21 days before an election.

REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

Registration of voters shall be conducted at the Office of Commissioner of Registration/ Superintendent of Elections, Monmouth County Special Services Complex, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold, each weekday between the hours of 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM, or at the municipal offices in the voter's community each weekday during business hours.

EVENING REGISTRATION

For the convenience of the voter, the Office of Superintendent of Elections/Commissioner of Registration shall remain open from 4:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 13, 2026.

REGISTRATION BY MAIL

Anyone wishing to register by mail may do so by requesting mail registration forms from the Office of Commissioner of Registration/Superintendent of Elections, Monmouth County Special Services Complex, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold, New Jersey 07728, or call (732) 431-7780.

ATTENTION VOTERS WHO HAVE MOVED

If you are a registered voter in Monmouth County and have moved within the County, you should submit a change of address with the Commissioner of Registration, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold, NJ, 07728 phone #732-431-7780.

If you are a registered voter who has moved within the County, and you did not notify the County Commissioner of Registration of your new address, you will be permitted to vote at this election as follows: (1) Go to the polling place for the election district in which you reside on election day. (2) Tell the District Election Board Member that you are registered to vote but have moved within the County. (3) You will be permitted to vote by provisional ballot. You will need to provide your name, current and old addresses, date of birth and signature on the envelope provided with the ballot. You may call the Commissioner of Registration or your Municipal Clerk to determine your proper polling place location.

NOTE: HAVA (Help America Vote Act) REQUIREMENTS

First-time "Mail-in registrants, voting in a Federal Election **MUST** provide **I.D.** before voting.

Under New Jersey law you have the right to vote in privacy, to have a reasonable amount of time to vote, to receive a replacement ballot if you spoil the first one, and to bring written material into the polling place for your personal use.

A "Voter's Bill of Rights" will be prominently displayed at your polling place. If you believe that your right to vote has been violated in any way, you should immediately notify your county Board of Elections or county Superintendent of Elections.

"Pursuant to provisions of the Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act of 1984" (Public law 98-435), a telecommunication device for the deaf (TDD) is maintained at the Election Division, Department of State, Trenton, New Jersey.

MUNICIPAL PUBLIC QUESTIONS

Colts Neck Township

Municipal Question

Should Colts Neck Township increase the annual levy for Open Space, Farmland and Historic Preservation, within Colts Neck Township from the amount of \$0.012 per \$100 to the amount of \$0.027 per \$100 of assessed valuation of real property?

Explanatory Statement

The proposed referendum seeks to increase the dedicated farmland, open space and historic preservation tax from the current \$0.012 to \$0.027 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The increase is being proposed to provide additional funds to afford the Township the ability to acquire additional land dedicated for farmland, open space and/or historic preservation, in furtherance of the Township's commitment to maintaining the rural character of the Township by preserving open space.

For an average home assessed at \$1,367,047, this would increase the tax payment from \$164.05 per year to \$369.10 per year. Revenues from this dedicated open space tax will be used for farmland, open space and historic preservation, including debt service.

Deal Borough

Municipal Question

Should the BOROUGH OF DEAL withdraw from the Monmouth County Library System?

Explanatory Statement

The voters of the Borough of Deal are asked whether to withdraw from the Monmouth County Library System and authorize the withdrawal process directing Municipal Officials to take all actions necessary to effectuate the withdrawal.

Deal Borough does not maintain a public library within its municipal boundaries and contributes approximately Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) annually toward the operation of the Monmouth County Library System.

The Mayor and Commissioners have undertaken a review of the financial burden associated with continued participation in the Monmouth County Library System and found that it is disproportionate to the services utilized by Borough residents. The Board of Commissioners have concluded that in the efforts to reduce the tax burden on its residents and promote fiscal responsibility, it is in the best interests of the Borough to withdraw from the Monmouth County Library System at the earliest date permitted by law.

The Borough intends to continue providing free public library services to its residents in accordance with New Jersey law and evaluating options including entering into agreements with neighboring public libraries and/or other authorized library providers.

The Borough recognized that withdrawal from the Monmouth County Library System is governed by provisions of New Jersey law (N.J.S.A. 40:33-13b and N.J.S.A. 40:54-7.1).

Interpretive Statement

Voting YES means you WANT the Borough to WITHDRAW from the Monmouth County Library System.

Voting NO means you DO NOT WANT the Borough to withdraw from the Monmouth County Library System.

SCHOOL PUBLIC QUESTIONS**Neptune City Board of Education****Bond Proposal Question**

The Board of Education of the Borough of Neptune City in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Board") is authorized to (a) undertake various improvements, renovations, and upgrades at Woodrow Wilson School, including but not limited to the replacement of various portions of roofing, various HVAC and electrical repairs and upgrades, renovations to toilet rooms, and various improvements to the corridor, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, equipment, and any site work; (b) appropriate \$6,987,840 for such acquisition and improvements; and (c) issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$6,987,840.

The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$6,987,840. The projects include \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State of New Jersey (the "State") support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage is equal to 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.
