Revenues are expected to be \$73,750 higher (105.4%) than 2021-2022's budget due to projected financings. 2022-2023 expenses are \$23,000 higher (22.5%) than 2021-2022 expenses. The increase represents legal and financial advisory fee increases due to the professionals handling additional services until a MCIA Secretary is hired. Due to projected increase in revenues, the MCIA expects that revenues will be enough to cover expenses.

The MCIA is a conduit financing entity and therefore does not have a Capital Program. The state of the local/regional economy will not effect the budget.
