The camp form packet with all four forms and special accommodation forms, if needed, must be completed and returned prior to attending camp. Forms can be found at www.monmouthcountyparks.com or call 732 842-4000, ext. 4312, to have them mailed to you.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

- Please see the Dorbrook Summer Camps Map for camp meeting locations.
- Many different camps start at the same time each week. To ensure an easier drop-off, please bring your receipt with you on the first day of camp.
- Staff arrives 15 minutes before your camp's start time.
- Each day campers will need to be signed in and out. Campers cannot be released to anyone not listed on the Parent Authorization Form.
- Campers should be picked up promptly at the end of camp.
- Please park in designated parking areas.

PLEASE BRING TO CAMP

- Sneakers – No sandals, flip flops, Crocs or any open-toed shoes
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen and/or a hat
- Snack and drink for half day camps
- Snack, drinks and lunch for full day camps
- Wear or bring a bathing suit and towel each day. All camps do not swim every day, but we may use sprinklers, water games, or possibly the Sprayground on very hot days.
- Campers may bring their own equipment for single-sport camps.
- Most campers use backpacks to keep their belongings together.
- Please mark all items with your child's name.

DO NOT BRING TO CAMP

- Food or snacks containing nuts, nut oil, or nut byproducts
- Personal items including toys and electronics
- Money for snack machines. Children are not permitted to go to snack or soda machines during camp.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Many camps are held rain or shine. Indoor activities are planned in the event of bad weather.

Most single-sports camps are cancelled in the event of bad weather. If it begins to rain once a camp has begun

indoor activities are planned for the duration of the day. If availability allows, campers may be bussed over to the gym at the Fort Monmouth Recreation Center. Parents will be contacted and asked for permission before any camper leaves the park.

Pick up for any outdoor camp that was moved indoors may be at the Dorbrook Visitor Center.

If at any time you are unsure as to whether your camp will be held, please call the Weather Cancellation Number at 732-842-4000 Ext 6. A recorded message will be in place ONE HOUR prior to the camp's starting time. If your camp is not listed on the message, it is running as scheduled.

CAMP TRIPS

- Please refer to your camp's description on our website for details if your camp will travel in one of our Monmouth County Park System mini-buses.
- Mini buses are inspected before each trip and driven by Park System staff with Commercial Drivers Licenses.
- Campers may not purchase food or drinks from concession areas while on field trips unless the camp is having lunch and they need to purchase their lunch.
- Campers may bring money to purchase souvenirs. Campers are responsible for keeping their money or any purchased items while on a field trip.
