



Monmouth County Park System Hominy Hill Golf Administration Building

PROJECT INFORMATION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project consists of the rehabilitation to the existing building including the replacement of the outmoded electrical service, wiring and light fixtures; removal of 4 bathrooms; ADA renovation of 2 toilet rooms; and miscellaneous interior finish refurbishments.

REASON FOR PROJECT:

The Golf Administration Building houses the Monmouth County Park System Golf Operations staff for all County Golf Courses. This project is part of the overall plan to renovate golf facilities at Hominy Hill to include the main building in a future phase.

The Golf Administration Building serves as a prominent element enhancing the landscaped allee leading to the historic Hominy Hill Golf Center that is scheduled for a complete renovation in 2019.

PROJECT STATUS:

New windows and doors have been installed in the building along with new mechanical systems. The contract for this phase will be awarded in December 2018 with a projected start date of January 2019 and an estimated construction window of 4 months.
