



Monmouth County Park System Construction of Roberts Rd. Mid-block Crossing, Holmdel Park

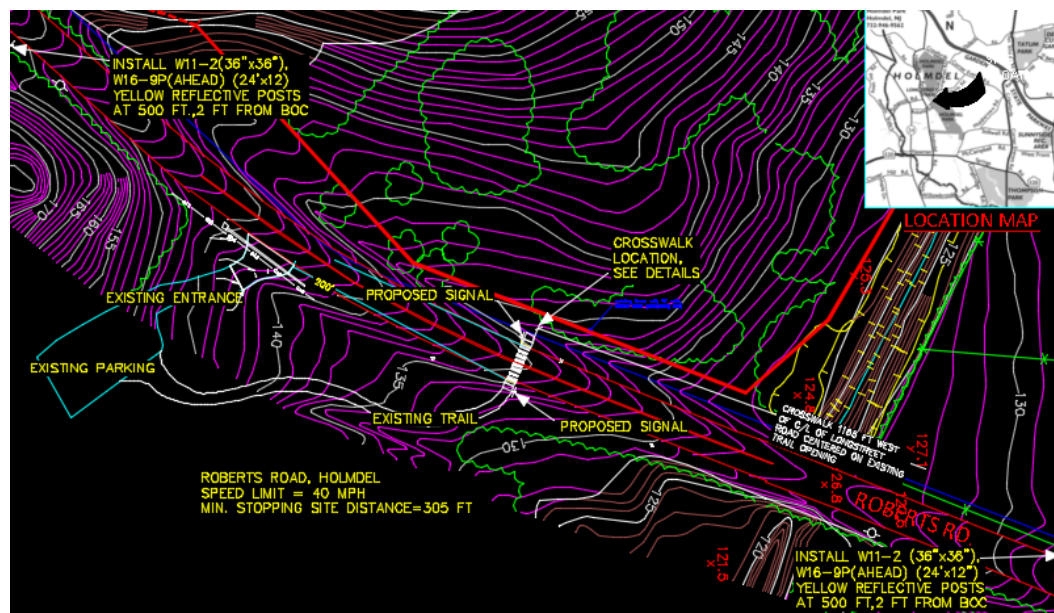
PROJECT INFORMATION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project will consist of a traditional striped crosswalk with ADA accessible concrete landings on either side. The landings will also have detectable warning strips to mark the edge of the pavement. The crossing will feature a pedestrian activated flashing yellow signal, and warning signs to notify drivers to yield when pedestrians want to cross the road.

REASON FOR PROJECT:

Holmdel Park is bisected diagonally by Roberts Road. While the main developed section of the park is north of Roberts Road, the undeveloped Ramanessin section lies to the south. Park patrons must cross it to access the Ramanessin section trails. This can be dangerous since there are no intersections to place a crosswalk. Several locations for the best crossing were looked at. MCPS staff worked with Monmouth County Engineering and Holmdel Township to finalize the location of the mid-block crosswalk.



PROJECT STATUS: *The contract has been awarded and construction was completed in November. The crosswalk is now open.*
