A fact-finding public hearing will be held on this application on **August 24, 2011, at 7:00 PM – 8:00 PM**, at the **Freehold Township Municipal Building, 1 Municipal Plaza, Freehold, NJ 07728**.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The purpose of the proposed project is to relieve congestion and improve the safety of the traveling public and local residents by upgrading the

current roadway geometry and intersection configurations. The proposed improvements promote vehicular safety while minimizing environmental impacts. The project will also replace three substandard bridge structures.

PROJECT STREET ADDRESS: The site is defined as the right-of-way of County Route 524 (Elton-Adelphia Road), bounded by New Jersey State Highway Route 9 and Wyckoff Road; the right-of-way of Edinburgh Drive, bounded by New Jersey State Highway Route 9 and County Route 524 (Elton-Adelphia Road); and the right-of-way of Halls Mill Road, bounded by County Route 524 (Elton-Adelphia Road) and New Jersey State Highway Route 33 Freeway.
