In order to develop a larger and better recreational area, it is recommended that certain land be sold and the proceeds help defray the expense involved.

Meeting adjourned.





A meeting of the Manasquan Planning Board was held in the Borough Hall on Monday evening December 5th, 1960 at 8 o'clock P. M. with Dr. Charles Tassini presiding.

Messrs. Dempsey, Howes, Jorgensen, Tassini, Voorhees, Wooley and Mayor Osborn were present.

Mr. Mc Cormack was absent.

Mr. Dempsey offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Mr. Wooley.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Board of The Borough of Manasquan that the Mayor and Council consider amending the Zoning Ordinance of The Borough of Manasquan to permit and authorize the mooring of private boats (excluding all boats used for hire whether party, charter or all other types of commercial boats) and to permit and authorize a fee to be charged for such mooring in the waters of Outlet Creek, Watson's Creek and the Glimmer Glass between East Main Street and the New York and Long Branch Railroad right-of-way.

On roll call the following members voted "Yes", Dempsey, Howes, Jorgensen, Tassini, Voorhees, Wooley and Osborn. "No", None.
