



NOTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF TOWNSHIP COUNCIL WITH FREEHOLD REGIONAL
HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND CONSTITUENT MUNICIPALITIES

April 13, 1980, AT FREEHOLD TWP. COURTROOM, SCHANK ROAD, FREEHOLD, NJ

At 7:50 P.M., the meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Mantei of Freehold Township. All municipalities were represented by one or more members of their respective governing bodies. Marlboro Township was represented by Council President Hyman C. Grossman and Councilmen Alan Ginsberg and James F. Hourihan, representing a majority of the Marlboro Township Council. Councilmen John Croddick and Howard Klau were absent.

Before going into any business, the announcement of the meeting was read pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act--such notice for Marlboro appearing in the April 11, 1980 issue of the Daily Register.

Mayor Mantei announced that a consensus of all municipalities had concluded on a cut in the budget of \$500,000. Council President Grossman objected for the record in that Marlboro had made no such commitment and had to think about it carefully because the Marlboro electorate had approved the budget. Discussion ensued about the need to have a unanimous vote on a specific number, otherwise the Commissioner would make the final decision. Council President Grossman asked whether we could get an indication from the District as to their response for if they were to object, the Commissioner would make the final decision anyway. The District indicated it would caucus on the point.


Council President Grossman stated that he had concern about the credibility of the Board regarding the building program and that part of his thinking on the budget had to do with overall credibility and keeping a commitment to move all four building projects together. Mr. Horrisberger assured all that all would be bid together although there was an indicated that bidding some earlier would save some money.

The Marlboro Township then had a caucus and agreed to support a budget cut of \$500,000. It was felt that had the voters known that the budget would have required a 21-cent increase, the vote in Marlboro may have been different; that the absence of detailed line items in the information supplied also prevented a better approach. The size of the budget was such as the cut in the opinion of most present would not present a hardship.

The Freehold Regional High School District went to caucus at approximately 8:40 P.M. at which time the Marlboro Township Council was called to its special meeting. The announcement of the meeting was read by the Council President. Councilman Ginsberg then introduced the resolution on the budget reduction with attached Schedule A. It was seconded by Councilman Hourihan and adopted by a unanimous vote of the councilmen present.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 P.M. upon a motion by Councilman Ginsberg, seconded by Councilman Hourihan and adopted unanimously by the councilmen present.

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING OF MAY 1, 1980- Township of Marlboro

The notice of the meeting was published in the Asbury Park Press of April 25, 1980. The meeting was called for the purpose of a general discussion of various aspects of township finances with the township's Auditors, Deloitte, Haskins & Sells with no formal action to be taken. Councilmen Croddick and Hourihan were absent, out of town.

The discussion began with only two members of Council present-Council President Grossman and Councilman Ginsberg at 7:15 P.M. Councilman Klau joined the meeting within a few minutes.

Others present included Messrs. S. Gerruto, R. Rooney and T. Carey from Deloitte, Haskins & Sells, Deputy Mayor Sid Leveson, Township Treasurer Sheila Fishkin. Mayor Hornik and Zoning Board Chairman Jay Stern joined the meeting at about 7:45 P.M.

Regarding the current status of the 1979 annual audit, it was indicated that work was in progress and the target date was still May 31 although some of the work presents a problem due to the fact that many of the records are still under custody at the Attorney General's Office. The special audit for the Community Development Block Grant program will start immediately following the regular audit.



Councilmen expressed their concern about some of the reporting aspects of the relationship of Council to the position of Auditor indicating their feeling that the Auditor as an appointee of Council was responsible to the Governing Body as a check and balance regarding the Administration and expected subsequent communication to follow this course.

Other subjects included the status of the Lloyd Road audit which was indicated to be ready the following day; the need to monitor accounts as to sufficiency of funding before commitments are made by any part of the government. Chairman Stern reviewed the budget needs of the Zoning Board indicating that part of his problem was late receipt of bills. It was indicated that bills should be submitted as work was completed so that proper funding of liabilities could be maintained.

The need for a capital improvement program and the scheduling of a bond sale to fund outstanding notes was also discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 P.M.



Dear Mayor Hornik:

Limited rainfall and high temperatures have recently caused excessive demands upon the Marlboro Township Municipal Utilities Authority's water distribution system, which system includes both the original M.U.A. area and the former Central Jersey Water Company area only. This has resulted in excessive drains upon the system for use not related to domestic and sanitary purposes and fire protection. We now have a temporary lack of sufficient water capacity which has resulted in a lowering of the normal water levels of the sources of water supply to the M.T.M.U.A.

To that end, excessive use of sprinkling systems, the filling of swimming pools and other similar uses of water not related to domestic, sanitary and fire protection services may cause a serious reduction in adequate pressure to M.T.M.U.A. customers during this period, and would pose a hazard to the health, safety and well-being of M.T.M.U.A. customers if said non-domestic, sanitary and fire protection uses are not limited.

Accordingly, the Marlboro Township Municipal Utilities Authority requests that you, with the advice and consent of Council, enact Ordinance No. 13-1969, and proclaim that a water emergency exists, requiring conservation of water for domestic, sanitary and fire protection uses only. We would further request that the users of the M.T.M.U.A. water distribution system be directed that no lawn sprinkling be done on weekends, nor during daylight hours and that no swimming pool filling be performed until this emergency is deemed terminated.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
THE PROCLAMATION OF AN
EMERGENCY TO PROVIDE FOR
THE RESTRICTION OF THE USE
OF WATER FOR THE SPRINK-
LING OF LAWNS, FILLING OF
SWIM POOLS AND OTHER RE-
LATED USES FROM PUBLIC
UTILITY WATER SYSTEMS SER-
VING RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF MARLBORO.

WHEREAS, protracted periods of high temperatures and limited rainfall may cause excessive demands upon the water systems of the public utilities serving the residents of the Township resulting in excessive drains upon said systems for use not related to domestic and sanitary purposes and fire protection; and

WHEREAS, a temporary lack of sufficient water supply may also result in a lowering of the normal water level of the sources of water supply to the public utilities serving the residents of the Township and the excessive use of water during the spring, summer and fall months caused by sprinkling of lawns, filling of swim pools and other similar use not related to the use of water for domestic and sanitary purposes and fire protection may cause a serious reduction in adequate pressure to some residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, grave inequities result whereby some residents furnished water constantly use water for such sprinkling while other residents do not receive any water as a result of the inadequate pressure; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Township, it is necessary to promptly take all reasonable precautions and measures to conserve water and to prevent the inequities hereinbefore mentioned, as hereinafter provided; Now Therefore,

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Marlboro in the County of Monmouth:

Section 1. This ordinance shall become effective at such time as the mayor, with the advice and consent of two-thirds of the council, formally proclaims that in the judgment of the mayor and council an emergency exists requiring the taking of such measures for the conservation of water for domestic and sanitary purposes and fire protection as are hereinafter specified in section two.

Section 2. Upon the making of such proclamation of emergency, the mayor shall proclaim whether the emergency is of the type or character requiring the restricted use of water hereinafter set forth under subparagraph "(a)" or "(b)":

(a) Proclamation (a) — shall prohibit, until such proclamation shall be terminated, use of water from the public utilities serving the Township for sprinkling lawns, filling of swim pools and other related uses on certain days of the week and during certain hours of the day as specified in a resolution adopted by the council based upon recommendations made by the head of the Division of Health and/or the engineer employed

by the Municipal Utilities Authority. The said division head and/or engineer employed by the Municipal Utilities Authority from time to time shall submit recommendations to the business administrator for consideration by the mayor and council in determining the need to adopt a resolution for a proclamation of this type.

(b) Proclamation (b) — shall prohibit the use of water from the public utilities serving the Township for the sprinkling of lawns and filling of swim pools until such proclamation shall be terminated. Said proclamation shall be based upon recommendation made by the head of the Division of Health and/or engineer employed by the Municipal Utilities Authority, or employees under their supervision, shall, from time to time, submit recommendations to the business administrator for consideration by the mayor and council in determining the need for a proclamation of this type.

Section 3. Immediately following the issuing of any of the emergency proclamations hereinbefore provided, notice thereof specifying its type and character shall be given by the Township Clerk by mailing written notice thereof to the users of the public utility facilities involved within 48 hours after the issuing of said proclamation and/or by causing said proclamation of emergency to be published forthwith in a newspaper published or circulated in the Township.

Section 4. Upon the making of the proclamation of emergency as provided in section 2 hereof, the provisions of this article shall remain effective until the date when the mayor, with the advice and consent of at least two-thirds vote of the council, shall proclaim and declare such emergency terminated.

Section 5. Seventy-two (72) days after the declaration of emergency and during its continuance any person who violates any of the restrictions imposed thereby shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00.
